The practical component of assessor competence includes:

Duration of the training:

- The contact phase covers 4 days.
- It includes theory and practical work as well as formative and summative assessments (part portfolio building).
- The Summative assessment consist of two assignments (practical) to be carried out by candidates, one using role-play in class, the other a workplace assessment, and the completion of 1 x Workbook (covering the critical Crossfield outcomes and essential embedded knowledge as per US 115753).
- To complete the course, conduct assessments and complete all the portfolio building in four days, it is required that candidates do some homework as well (e.g. to complete the workbooks).
