UNIT STANDARD (ID 115759): MODERATE OUTCOMES-BASED ASSESSMENTS, NQF LEVEL 6, CREDITS 10

The practical component of moderator competence includes:

- Demonstrate Understanding of Moderation within the Outcomes-based Assessment system.
- Plan and Prepare for Moderation.
- Conduct Moderation.
- Advise and Support Assessors.
- Report, Record and Administer Moderation.
- Review Moderation Systems and Processes.

Duration of the training:

- The contact phase covers 4 days.
- It includes theory and practical work as well as formative and summative assessments (portfolio building).
- The assignments consist of two moderations (practical) to be carried out by candidates and the completion of 3 x Workbooks (covering all critical Crossfield outcomes and essential embedded knowledge).
- To complete the course, conduct assessments and complete portfolio building in four days, it is required that candidates do some homework as well (e.g. to complete the workbooks).

Any person who wants to moderate in the NQF system.
